b) a brief statement of what fellowship support you would like to receive (aside from full support) and why -- e.g. you expect to have full support from other sources for two quarters, but only partial support for the third quarter, and are therefore requesting supplemental funding for that third quarter. It will help us if we know you are in need of as much support as possible (which would likely be no more than one quarter's support, and probably less), or if you need your non-resident tuition covered one quarter when you TA, or if you just need a small monthly stipend to supplement an outside scholarship, or if your Major Professor needs us to supplement your salary for one or more quarters, etc.

c) A cv or resume (optional).
